				Our Center for Rehabilitation through Imagination focuses on the phenomenon of play and its liberating and creative impact on the social rehabilitation, reintegration and (re)socialization of stigmatized and vulnerable groups and individuals. We study whether, how and to what extent the process of rehabilitation can be fostered through the arts , literature and theatrical performance. Man is by his nature and development destined to be on the move, to play. Apart from his basic instincts for self-preservation and continuation of species, his need to move and play has determined and justified the purpose of his existence since the very beginning of his life on earth. We believe that work on a theatrical performance is the most beneficial since it offers various possibilities of interaction. Although it is not easy, we try to make good use of these possibilities by gradually building up a dramatic process throughout which we do not become who we really are but who we might be, we obtain the features we do not originally possess but could possess them. Theatre can help individuals gain important insights into their own potential, intentions, identity and place in a society, and to this end it uses different means of artistic expression such as dramatic texts, directorial
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				interventions and actors and their play. The Shelter Foundation is an independent organization. It is not controlled by the state, municipalities, political or market actors, but the Foundation seeks constructive cooperation with all organizations that contribute to the alleviation of the situation of homeless people.

The Shelter Foundation is a secular organization. It is not directly or indirectly affiliated with any religious denomination, but its values are open to all moderate orientations that can provide a home for the stranger, the outcast, the different, the afflicted and the humiliated.

The Shelter Foundation is the first organization to set up and run a Care Centre providing professional social assistance for people experiencing homelessness, the first organization to set up a Day Centre for homeless people providing professional social services and a cultural pastime, is the first organization to start a street newspaper for homeless people called 'Without a Roof', the first organization to set up a 24-hour Dispatch Service and a crisis car, a convalescent home and a central luggage storage to help the homeless, the first organization to set up a home for elderly homeless people providing permanent accommodation and a "voucher scheme" to help people out of homelessness.

The activities of the Shelter Foundation cover all forms of homelessness, from alleviating the crisis situation of the permanently excluded, the homeless, the homeless without shelter, to supporting people who have been homeless for a longer or shorter period of time, to supporting people living in institutions, to dealing with the social affairs of people without a safe home, in sublets, shelters, workhouses.

One of the values of the Shelter Foundation is that direct assistance can only be effective if different organizations and people work together. Therefore, the Foundation is constantly playing a significant role in the professional and day-to-day coordination of the activities of the so-called homeless care organizations and other partner organizations (regional dispatching services, Budapest street services, crisis cars, night shelters, etc.)

In addition to providing direct assistance, the Shelter Foundation attaches particular importance to respecting the human dignity of people who are homeless or threatened with homelessness, to fairly recognizing and strengthening their autonomous and responsible decision-making, to expressing and protecting the interests of people who are homeless in various ways, and to preventing the possibility of such situations.

They can't replace the absent parent, but they can offer experiences, community, challenge, affirmation, and the companionship of others in similar situations.

Their aim is to organize clubs, excursions and programmes to help children learning, support sports and leisure activities prevent them from being permanently excluded from society, and if only for a short time but even for a short time, to make them forget their negative experiences. They strive to give back their self-confidence, to make them aware of their own talents, to give them the chance to a better childhood, a happier life. An adult life in which they are already no longer longing, no longer forced into contact with sin, crime...

Bagázs Non-profit Association

Since 2011, Bagázs Non-profit Association has been working to create a society where Roma people can achieve their goals. To achieve this, they sensitize the majority society to reduce their existing prejudices and develop the minority members to be able to act to achieve their goals.

They are currently working on the development and dissemination of a model programme based on a co-existence approach to help segregated communities across the country in the 400-souls Roma settlement of Bag, 40 km from Budapest. In their mentoring programme, Roma women (among others) mentor their fellow Roma people. An integral part of the mentoring programme is the Women's Club, which is held on a weekly or bi-weekly basis in Bag.

Their programmes aim to empower local people to identify their goals and the pathways to them. They are always based on local needs, so they are constantly evolving and developing. They work in communities every day of the week to build trust.

They don't donate: they give people a chance to make a difference, not a handout. They believe that donating reinforces entrenched patterns, makes people vulnerable and reduces individual and community empowerment.

They approach the problem at multiple levels: their work extends beyond the settlements to the local village community and mainstream society, working with nearly 100 volunteers.

Budapest Methodological Centre of Social Policy and Its Institutions

Budapest Methodological Centre of Social Policy and Its Institutions (BMSZKI) is the homeless care organization of the Municipality of Budapest. It was established in 1993, when it provided care in "only" 8 sites. Since then, there has hardly been a year without some significant change in the life of BMSZKI: new institutions have been created, old ones have been closed, transformed, expanded. The professional activity of the institution has also been constantly changing. They have made great efforts to provide the highest quality of care to the vulnerable people who come to them, who have lost their dignity. They have developed a methodology for assessing the needs of homeless people. They have set up a dedicated professional network to deal effectively with housing, employment, health-addiction and social housing problems. They have differentiated the profile of their

institutions according to the needs of homeless people and tailored their services to the needs that arise. For example

- providing 'low-threshold' services - unconditional or with minimum (e.g. public health) conditions - benefits to people who would otherwise be without institutional care;
- through the 'Opening up the Street' programme, they have set up 'hostels' to enable homeless people living in the street to access their services;
- running "exit" shelters for people who, with targeted professional support, can move into independent housing in the short term. Housing support is also available to help them leave;
- they have made major improvements to the quality of care, for example by refurbishing their night shelters, also known as 'low-cost' hostels, reducing the number of beds in high occupancy hostels (or keeping them only for crisis periods) and opening several newly refurbished facilities specifically for people coming from the streets;
- they have improved their health services, including the creation of a modern hospital ward in the former Szabolcs Street Hospital.

TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATIONS

Temporary accommodation is available 24 hours a day for homeless people. All facilities have the possibility to

- sleep
- clean
- wash
- heat up and eat food
- socialize.

Admission to temporary hostels is decided by the Pre-Admission Team (FET).
