



Results

The main result is to facilitate the development of competence development pathways and to support access to them (Priority 1 of the 2020 Hungarian Institutions). Another important result is educating the educators, i.e. the development of the competences of professionals working with the target group, and the expansion of their repertoire of methodologies and tools.

The added value of the project is that it has been implemented at international level with the collaboration of several professions and professionals.

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Background

Criminals, addicts (detainees and ex-detainees) belong to the group of the disadvantaged because *generally* they had no six month of regular previous employment and/or had no previous secondary/vocational education, and/or a member of the ethnic minority. Tertiary and secondary criminal prevention is thus a mutual interest of all parties, since it has been proven that deprivation of freedom (i.e. detainment and prison) is the most expensive form of punishment. In the long run, the support of the (re)integration process may also stimulate a quality change in the relative security of the majority society. Reintegration processes prevent re-offending and reduce the risk of recidivism. However, they take a long time; require different types of development for the target group and the professionals working with them, and social sensitization is also essential. The organizations involved in the partnership are working in national/local and even international collaborations (especially as the problems of the target group affect several segments/sectors). Váltó-sáv Alapítvány felt that it had maximized the opportunities for local cooperation and that it certainly needed an international platform and impulses to develop.

Objectives

The main objective of the project is to reduce the marginalization of the target group of offenders, prisoners and released prisoners, addicts, people with high criminogenic risk, and to support their social integration, primarily and especially through creative, art therapy programmes; therefore, our further objective was to develop methods, expand tools, exchange knowledge and experience. The aim of the project is to apply innovative, non-formal creative

programmes and methods - personality development, raising the need and motivation to learn, reducing and addressing the knowledge, skills and competence deficit of the target group - i.e. to expand the methodological repertoire of adult education. To this end, an international strategic partnership has been established.
